- Opposition against Theresa May is growing among her own MPs as already 40 want her gone according to reports over the weekend > though at least 48 MPs are required to write to the chairman of the 1922 committee GBP starts feeling uneasy with EURGBP trading above its 21-day SMA (0,8874 today) at the beginning of the week

- China 10y bonds yields rose to their highest level since October 2014 > this appears in line with UST and Bund yields bouncing after holding important support levels (2,28 % in 10y UST yields) or rallying through short term trendline resistance (0,334 % in 10y Bund yields)
